Scouting does not collect personally identifying information about any individual web site user except when knowingly provided by such individual. Any information provided will only be used within the scouting organisation to contact members or to develop the movement.

3. Log details

When you access any website the server will store information about the pages you have viewed and any comments you have made on any forums, blogs, etc. Central Taunton Scout Group will only use this information to help them access their data for the number of hits on the website on certain dates etc.

4. Cookies

A cookie is a small data file that certain web sites write to your hard drive when you visit them. The only personal information a cookie can contain is information you supply yourself. A cookie can't read data off your hard disk or read cookie files created by other sites. Scouting uses cookies solely to improve the visitors experience. For example, to keep track of the access rights assigned to a user, or to automatically fill-in repetitive forms with information previously provided. This could occur when posting a message on the discussion forums or submitting a profile.

Most web site browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually change your browser settings to display a warning before accepting a cookie, or to refuse all cookies. However, if you choose to disable the receipt of

cookies from this web site, you may not be able to use certain features of the site.
